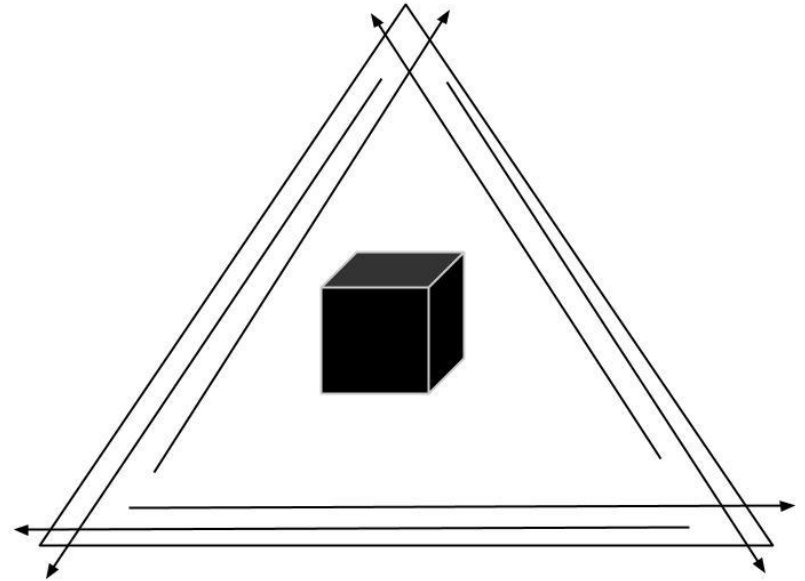

# Problem

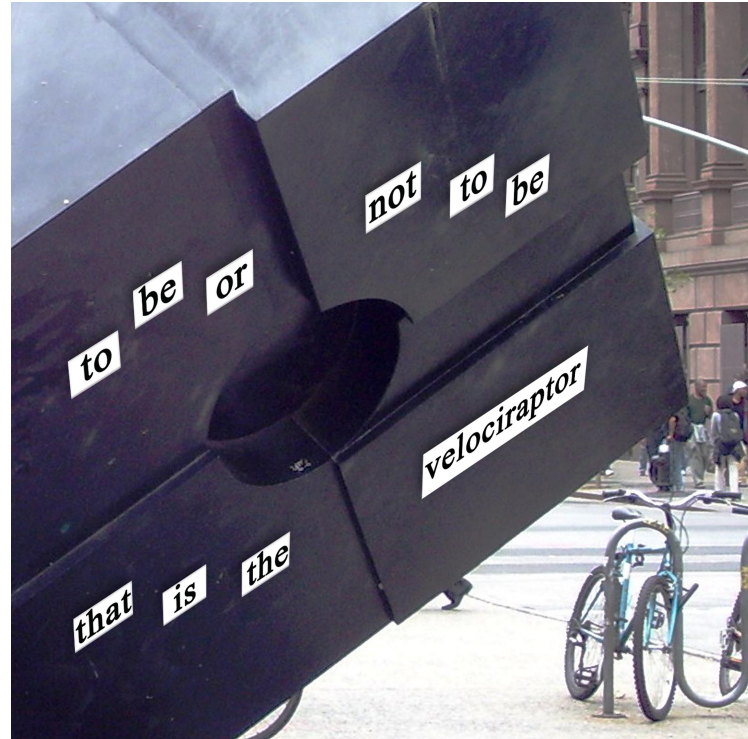
Action taken	# of people

Stopped to look at or admire the cube	15





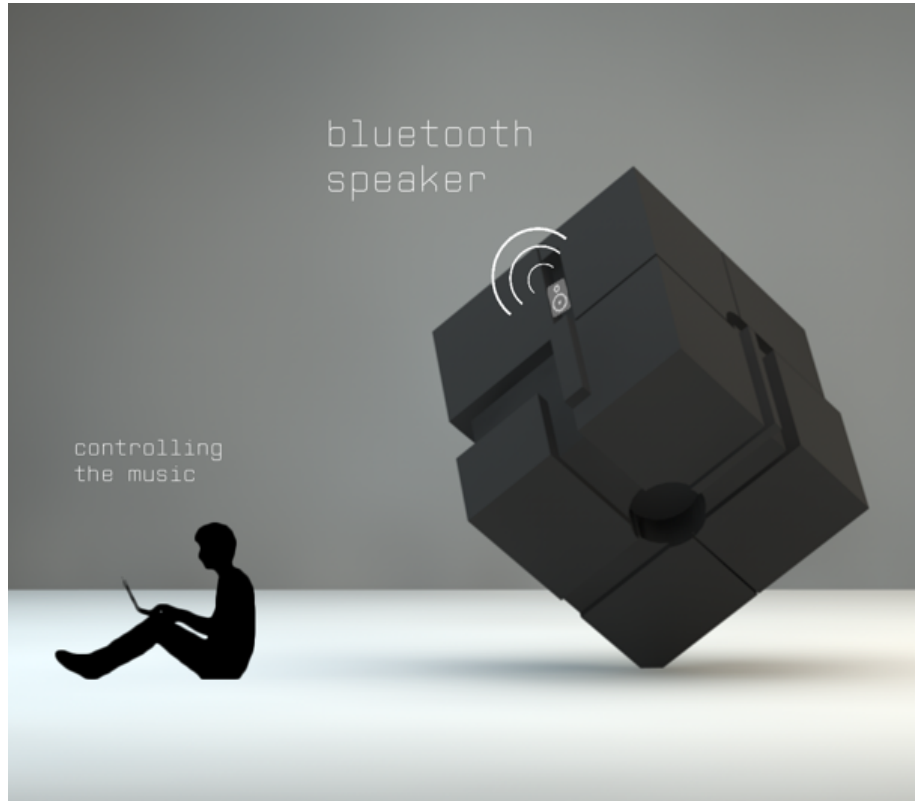
# Macbeth Quote Magnets

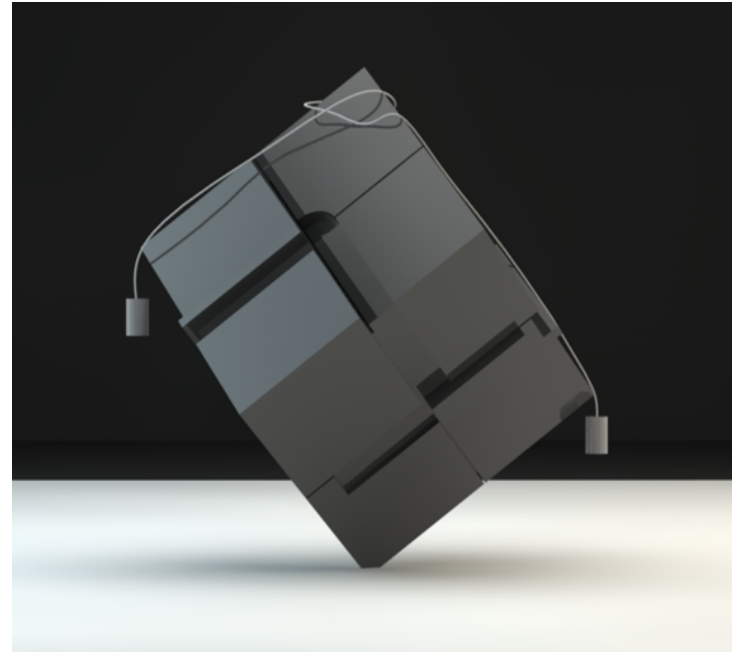
